



LUCK

Many people who say "GOOD LUCK" these days or "YOU ARE SO LUCKY" or "YOU ARE IN BAD LUCK" are all about bringing in about or portending something good or bad things to come. A chance of fortune that comes to happen in a good or bad way or winning or losing. People believe in this kind of stuff whether they succeed or fail by such chance rather than through one's own actions. While some people believe this fortune "LUCK" comes from the act of God's plan. I, Bro. Pouliot decides to find out whether this fortune of "LUCK" comes from $\aleph\aleph\aleph$ or not.

The first reason why I've decided to find out the truth, is because I have a strong reason to believe that this fortune "LUCK" isn't from $\aleph\aleph\aleph$. Because of what I've already learned a great deal about "SPORT" & "GAMBLE". Because people who play such sporting games are involved in gambling. Gamble that people often bet on an uncertain outcome, as of a game or sporting event. To win, while others will lose. Whether it is a wager on money or a prize of a trophy. We still need to have a better understanding of "LUCK", whether it's appropriate to say it or not. While searching throughout the scripture books, I did find a lot of evidence why $\aleph\aleph\aleph$ is against the ideal of fortune luck.

The lot will be cast into the lap, but all of its decisions are from $\aleph\aleph\aleph$. - Proverbs 16:33

Notice this lot cast into the lap, does this sound like gambling? The answer is NO, because the use of casting lots does not constitute a gamble any more than flipping a coin to decide where to go to dinner or how this is cast by voting decision. Other than throwing some dice to win the highest score for money or position is a gamble. That is why Proverbs 16:33 points out the decision is still from $\aleph\aleph\aleph$ doing.

There shall not be found among you one who makes his son or his daughter go through the fire, or one who practices divination, or an interpreter of signs, or an augur, or sorcerer, or one who casts magic spells, or one who consults a spirit of the dead, or spiritist, or one who inquires of the dead. For everyone doing these things is detestable to ייאל, and because of these detestable things ייאל your Creator Almighty ONE is driving them out from before you. - Deuteronomy 18:10-12

According to Deuteronomy 18:10-12, we can see why such different kinds of fortune are forbidden. So, this fortune "LUCK" is involved in this category. Just like how this word "AUGUR" is of a similar ideal event or circumstance that portends a good or bad outcome as luck.

There is another good example why we should not lead on our own understanding (Proverbs 3:5-7), but to lean on the knowledge of ייאל, and HE will make our paths the right way (Proverbs 3:6). Because Ecclesiastes 9:11-12 teaches us the role of understanding how things work or happening, all happen by ייאל. Why does everything not work by its nature or people, but all come from ייאל doing alone.

I looked again and saw under the sun that the race does not belong to the swift, the battle does not belong to the mighty, food does not belong to the wise, wealth does not belong to the intelligent, and success does not belong to the skillful, for time and chance befalls all of them. For man does not know his time. Just as fish are caught in a cruel net and like birds who are seized in a snare, so also humans are ensnared at a cruel time when it falls suddenly upon them.

For I know the plans that I am planning concerning you,' declares YHWH, 'plans for prosperity and not for harm, to give to you a future and a hope. - Jeremiah 29:11

As you can see how Jeremiah 29:11 describes to us; all things are being done by YHWH's glorifies future plan for us, and HE is our hope. Nothing else does that but YHWH alone.

You shall remember the Master, your Creator Almighty, for it is HE who gives you power to get wealth, that he may confirm his covenant that HE swore to your fathers, as it is this day. -

Deuteronomy 8:18

Blessed is the man who does not walk in the advice of the wicked; nor does he stand in the way of sinners; nor does he sit in the assembly of mockers. Instead, in the law of YHWH is his delight, and on his law he meditates day and night. And so, he is like a tree planted by streams of water that gives its fruit in its season; its leaf also does not wither.

Therefore all that he does prospers. Not so the wicked. Instead, they are like the chaff that the wind scatters. Therefore the wicked will not stand in the judgment, nor sinners in the congregation of the righteous; for YHWH knows the way of the righteous, but the way of the wicked will perish. - Psalm 1

So, we may now understand why we must NOT lean on such fortune talk of "LUCK" or say good or bad luck at all nor crossed fingers. Because it is useless to lift up people's hearts or minds in a positive way or not. Whether it is about winning or not. Nor mocking people because it's not of YHWH way but Satan evil work. We should be more mindful on thinking or say it's YHWH's blessing instead of luck.
