

# What's Wrong About Christmas?

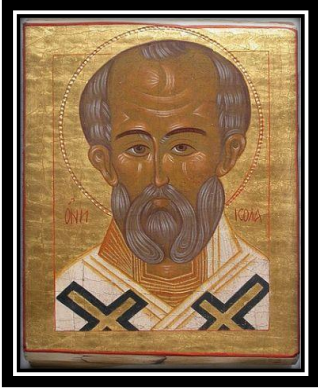
## *The Truth Behind About Christ-Mass Holiday*



One of the most popular American holidays is Christmas, which happens in December. Christmas is unlike any other holiday like Thanksgiving or Easter Sunday holiday. Most people in America mark this day on the 25th of December month. It's one of the federal holidays as well. A time of the year when families and/or friends come in gathering to exchange such gifts and/or cards. Some attend the Church house to listen to the sermons and Christmas carols.

I was in this childhood to remember how my parents used to display various kinds of colorful decorations around the house - including the green upright standing pine tree in the living room. A full of color flashing lights, mistletoe hanging above the ceiling, the nativity scenes outside, and the holly in some areas in the house have been a popular tradition for a long time now. Even an image of Santa Claus (known as Saint Nicholas) was posted on the front outside doors house. I remember all of this and how excited I felt at the time. I was a very curious and confusing child back then. It turned out that this whole ideal Christmas holiday was an evil pagan holiday. This is where I'm goanna explain how and why this is true.

Many say Christmas and Easter Sunday are the two most powerful and joyful times of the year. Not only by how families and friends come in gathering for the special dinner and exchange gifts but also by honoring the day Jesus Christ was born. This kind of memorial holiday is traditional to remember Jesus who is a very important icon person who died for humanity. Most fellowship believers who called themselves self-Christian claimed Jesus was sent here on earth to die for humanity to pay off their sins once and for all time. According to how they explained this from the New Testament Bible. Later in my early 30's, after a very long biblical investigation, I discovered some disturbing shocking truth. This holiday Christmas is an all-fraud kind of holiday. So, here again, in this document article, I will explain exactly what is wrong with this Christmas holiday tradition. And why do I no longer follow and practice this so-called Jesus Christ?



Starting with the history of how I found out about the Christmas customs and where it comes from. The first this I want to point out is about Santa Claus. Where did this icon Santa Claus come from? This is what I have dug in and learned more about Santa Claus. It turns out at the end that Santa Claus was invented by the Roman Catholic. So, let's hold on to that part for a few minutes. Most Catholic teachers have taught children that Christmas was all about this baby Jesus of Nazareth. He was born in Bethlehem and says he is the "Son of God". Children are being taught that there was a virgin young woman named Mary who gave birth to this baby Jesus. By God's plan as Savior to humanity. We were also told about these three wise men who came to visit this baby Jesus, as witnesses. To honor and give him a special gift. This is what Christmas is being taught about Jesus' birthday on December 25th.

While I was growing up back then, I was a little skippy about Santa Claus and Jesus, like I understood about Jesus but wasn't told enough about Santa Claus. Because I noticed how often the Children are admiring Santa Claus more than Jesus. We were told that Jesus Christ is more important to admire than anyone else, which is why I find that strange back then. I did once think maybe there was something secret about Santa Claus who may be Jesus Christ. A man who turns old, stays old, and lives up in the North Pole forever. Until one day I did some digging about Santa Claus. I found out that there was a story about a man named Nicolas. This man was being called Saint Nicolas, and somehow, I've once seen a little short film about him. I've also learned that this shortened form name for Santa Nicolas is "Nicolaitanes". It means the follower of Nicolas.



There is another strange part about Saint Nicolas' name. I've discovered the name Nicolas was originated from the Greek words, "Nikos" meaning "conqueror" or "destroyer," and Laos, meaning "people." My eyes wide open when I discovered that part. Because that name as "conqueror" or "destroyer" point me to an evil mighty man name Nimrod. A well-known name from Genesis book, chapter 10:8, is the destroyer of the people. What if the name Nicolas is merely the Greek word for Nimrod the whole time? Within two centuries after the great flood, Nimrod conquered the people and founded a man-made civilization. While alive, Nimrod commanded his subjects to worship him in place of the true Almighty ONE. Even after his death, many

of his followers continued to worship him as a divine heroic leader. He was called the Almighty Master as “Baal”.

There was another name that is commonly used throughout Asia Minor, it's “Santa.” That was another shocking part too. I've learned about this from Langer's Encyclopedia of World History: which explains how and why there is a name “Santa Claus” throughout history. How his name and all aspects of Christmas observance came from, was rooted in the Roman religion custom.



According to Roman history, I've discovered first from the old Buffalo Newspaper, dated November 22nd, 1984. Past evidence states that the earliest reference to Christmas has come from the second century after Jesus Christ's birth. A Roman celebration holiday was called Saturnalia. A day of the harvest festival that marked the winter solstice—the return of the sun—and honored Saturn, the god of sowing. This ancient Roman holiday

Saturnalia was a rowdy time, much opposed by the more austere leaders among the still-minority so-called Christian sect. Christmas developed, by one scholar who says, as a means of replacing the worship of the sun with the worship of the Son. By 529 A.D., after Christianity had become the official state religion of the Roman Empire, Emperor Justinian made Christmas a civic holiday. The celebration of Christmas reached its peak—some would say its worst moments—in the medieval period when it became a time for conspicuous consumption and unequalled revelry. This information evidence from the past is somewhat true. I remember other historical facts mentioned a lot in Roman or Greek history who worshiped the sun as their Almighty one God.

Later on in history, during the sixteenth century, Pope Gregory devised a new kind of calendar, which was unevenly adopted. The Eastern Orthodox and some Protestants have retained the Julian calendar, which meant them to celebrate on December 25th holiday 13 days later than their Gregorian counterparts. Most—but not all—of the Christian world agrees on this Gregorian calendar and the December 25th date as well. The pagan origins used this 25th December holiday name Christmas of the season date, as well as pagan origins of many customs (gift-giving and merrymaking from the Roman Saturnalia holiday; which also done the greenery, lights, and charity their Roman New Year; Yule logs and various foods from Teutonic feasts), have always fueled arguments against the holiday.

As a theologian asserted in the year 320 AD, **"We hold this day holy, not like the pagans because of the birth of the sun, but because of him who made it."** Now we can see how this Saturnalia was converting to Christmas, from SUN to SON. Here is another part, The name "Christmas" is a combination of the words "Christ" as Messiah (anointed one) and "Mass" for Rome Catholic prayer. This is why people in the later days don't see the Roman Holiday Saturnalia but a new set of holidays. Romans in the Catholic world somehow have evolved their old religion into a newer religion way to pull people into their kingdom's beliefs. To stay in power while they have the power to rule as many nations as they can.



No wonder why so many unknowingly about this man Nicol as, whether he is real or not. He still seems a fit for Santa Cause and Nimrods as well. Just as why maybe this Christ-Mass birthday holiday of Jesus was originally carried out from this same pagan birthday Saturnalia holiday of Nimrod. Nimrod, the Almighty man who led and created the tower of Baal. Tried to reach heaven to make equal with the Creator ONE, אֱלֹהִים's. Now looking at the

Christmas honors day of Jesus Christ as "Nicolas" from Nimrod, before creating him like an old fella as Santa-Cause who wore at first a green and white long suit before the color was changed into a red and white suit color.

In our present-day world, billions of people still believe in Jesus Christ, the Nazarene which is told by this story from the New Testament Bible. Still don't have the opportunity to find out where the name Jesus Christ comes from before our modern-day language exit. Many also did not take enough heart to dig in and find out why there are many conflicts and errors between the Old Testament and New Testament books. Now, let's me point out some of the scripture evidence why אֱלֹהִים forbidden such icon of any kind of idols. Like why this so-called Christ-Mass, Santa Claus, and/or the Christmas tree icon idolatry things. Read the book of Jeremiah chapter 10:1-7.

**Hear ye the word which the אֱלֹהִים speaketh unto you, O house of Israel:**

**Thus saith the *אֱלֹהִים*, Learn not the way of the heathen, and be not dismayed at the signs of heaven; for the heathen are dismayed at them.**

**For the customs of the people are vain: for one cutteth a tree out of the forest, the work of the hands of the workman, with the axe.**

**They deck it with silver and with gold; they fasten it with nails and with hammers, that it move not.**

**They are upright as the palm tree, but speak not: they must needs be borne, because they cannot go. Be not afraid of them; for they cannot do evil, neither also is it in them to do good.**

**Forasmuch as there is none like unto thee, O *אֱלֹהִים*; thou art great, and thy name is great in might.**

**Who would not fear thee, O King of nations? for to thee doth it appertain: forasmuch as among all the wise men of the nations, and in all their kingdoms, there is none like unto thee.**

Some people may refer to Jeremiah 10:1-7 as a reason to reject the celebration of Christmas or the use of Christmas trees. They may claim that this passage condemns the practice of cutting down a tree, shaping it, adorning it with silver and gold, and setting it up in one's home as a form of idolatry. However, this interpretation is not accurate or fair to the context of Jeremiah's message. Jeremiah was not talking about Christmas trees, which are a relatively modern custom that originated in northern Europe, not in ancient Israel or its neighboring nations. Jeremiah was talking about the making of wooden idols, which were common in the pagan cultures of his time. These idols were carved out of trees, covered with precious metals, and fastened to a base so they would not fall over. They then worshiped their false Creator Supreme Fathers (gods), even though they had no life or power. Jeremiah was warning the people of Israel not to follow the ways of the nations or be afraid of their false Supreme Fathers, but to trust in the true and living Creator Father, *אֱלֹהִים*, who is incomparable and sovereign over all creation. Jeremiah 10:1-7 has nothing to do with Christmas or Christmas trees, but with the folly and futility of idolatry. Therefore, it is not a valid reason to reject the celebration of Christmas or the use of Christmas trees, unless one is worshiping them as false Supreme Fathers, which is very unlikely. Yet, Christmas is still a false hope to celebrate the time to remember and rejoice in the birth of Jesus Christ, the so-called "Son of God", who they claimed came from heaven, came into the world to save us from our sins, etc...

Jeremiah chapter 10 is not the only area in the Bible where people claim the fitting about the Christmas tree. Two another scripture example some people claim about the Christmas tree is Isaiah 60:13. This scripture passage mentions the glory of Lebanon, the juniper, the box tree, and the cypress coming to beautify the place of God's sanctuary. Some people may see this as a prophecy of the evergreen trees being used to decorate the church or the home during Christmas. This scripture passage has zero evidence about this so-called Christmas tree.

The other scripture passages some people also point out about the Christmas tree is in Ezekiel 17:22-24. This passage describes how **אֶלֶף** will take a sprig from the lofty top of a cedar and plant it on a high and lofty mountain, and it will become a majestic cedar, under which every kind of bird will dwell. Some people have seen this as a symbol of Christ, who is the shoot from the stump of Jesse (Isaiah 11:1), and who provides shelter and salvation for all nations. Some may also see a connection to the Christmas tree, which is often topped with a star or an angel, and which may have bird ornaments hanging on its branches. Again, this scripture passage has zero evidence about this so-called Christmas tree.

Since the Christmas tree tradition doesn't have anything to do with the Bible at all, zero evidence. Then where did this Christmas tree icon or custom come from? There is history regarding the Christmas tree that can traced back to ancient Egypt and Rome. There are evergreen tree symbols they've used. The first documented of this Christmas tree originated in Germany during the Middle Ages. The tree was a "paradise tree," a fir tree hung with apples, that represented the Garden of Eden. The tree was the main prop of a popular medieval play about Adam and Eve. In 1419, a guild in Freiburg put up a tree decorated with apples, flour-paste wafers, tinsel, and gingerbread. In the 16th century, devout Christians in Germany began bringing decorated trees into their homes. Some built Christmas pyramids of wood and decorated them with evergreens and candles if wood was scarce.

And from the Romans custom, they placed them around the temples to honor Saturn, the god of agriculture. But the first time the evergreen was used as a Christmas tree was either in Tallinn, Estonia, or Riga, Latvia. (Each city says it is the true home of the first Christmas tree.) In the 16th century, German Christians brought the trees inside their homes as a symbol of everlasting life. When news spread that Queen Victoria had her German husband, Prince Albert, set up a Christmas tree in their palace, the practice suddenly became the height of Christmas symbolism in England and even in the American New World.

What you have just read, you can see why this history is linked with the Genesis story about the Garden of Eden and Adam and Eve. Yet, still, the Scripture books do not say anything about "Christmas", "Christmas trees", or even "Santa Claus". All of those



Christmas trees and the holiday ideal holiday are pagan idolatry.  $\text{אֱלֹהִים}$  forbade such idolatry and he forced people who fell in for idolatry to end up cutting off the Yisraelites nation. The reason why the ancient people who were once Yisraelites people were cut off (removed) of Yisrael. They have invariably been worshiped idols too often. The masses needed the heavenly Father near at hand—and this meant those that could be seen. So, in part because of the environment in which they lived before the heavenly Father could instruct Yisrael how to properly worship Him, He first had to show them how not to worship Him. In Exodus 20:4-6 records the Second Commandment. Here is what HE explicit directive once again:



***“YOU SHALL NOT MAKE UNTO YOU ANY GRAVEN IMAGE, or any likeness of any thing that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth: you shall not bow down yourself to them, nor serve them: for I the  $\text{אֱלֹהִים}$  your Supreme Creator Father, am a jealous Supreme Father, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate Me; and showing mercy unto thousands of them that love Me, and keep My commandments.”***

This commandment is a very broad, sweeping, explicit prohibition intended to cover every form of false worship involving every other kind of supposed “god,” and representation of such, that human beings with creative human reasoning could devise. Like any parent whose children chose to come home to a different house and parents after school, the Parent who made all human beings—His children—would certainly be jealous if they went off after idols and false gods.

$\text{אֱלֹהִים}$  had specifically clearly defined why it is forbidden ways to look into or worship such idol icons. He realized human nature’s tendency to justify loopholes around His instructions. The First Commandment forbids having other Supreme Fathers (gods) before the true ONE,  $\text{אֱלֹהִים}$ . The Second Commandment forbids using an image to represent the true Creator ONE,  $\text{אֱלֹהִים}$  or any false creator mighty one. This commandment deals specifically with using physical images for worship or as representations of anything related to worship. This does not condemn the existence of statues or pictures in general—only their use for worship. Therefore, using any statue or picture to represent  $\text{אֱלֹהִים}$  is expressly forbidden. Man is to worship, bow down to, and serve the Supreme Father,  $\text{אֱלֹהִים}$ , who does not allow a man to transfer this same honor to an image representing Him. He strongly warned Yisrael of this danger. This is

the same reason goes with Jesus Christ who **אֱלֹהִים** never has sent anyone from the heavens to die for a man's sins. Yet, people created and built an iconic image of Jesus hanging dead on the cross.

Please notice again how or why **אֱלֹהִים** specific instructed Moses: **"You shall not make with Me gods of silver, neither shall you make unto you gods of gold"** (Ex. 20:23). These were **אֱלֹהִים**'s first words to Moses after giving him the Ten Commandments! Again, notice what verses 5-6 said: **"... for I, אֱלֹהִים your Supreme Father am a jealous Creator ONE, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate Me; and showing mercy unto thousands of them that love Me, and keep My commandments."** If people persist in idol worship, **אֱלֹהִים** will not only punish them, but also their children, grandchildren, and great-grandchildren. No other commandment gives such detailed implications.

**אֱלֹהִים** hates the idolatry thing and directly equates it with hating Him! However, **אֱלֹהִים** have promises to bless those who love and obey Him! Individuals who choose to obey HIM will not be punished for their parents' disobedience.

**אֱלֹהִים** does not want us to make up such fiction in vain about what the scriptures (Biblical) teach. Why do some churches use the 25th December holiday name or a song in a blasphemous way? Why have we kept on changing for the better when we shouldn't have? Prophet Daniel knew one day people would desire to change in time and law:

**"He (unbeliever) will speak against the Most-High and oppress his saints and try to change the set times and the laws. The saints will be handed over to him for a time, times and half a time."** (Daniel 7:25)

One of the most startling things about this power is that it would "think to change times and laws" (Daniel 7:25) Here's a man that sets himself up as equal with the **אֱלֹהִים**, and dares to tamper with His law – the constitution of the universe! With blasphemous audacity, he does his work. So, the truth in history, is Roman Catholic did change **אֱלֹהִים**'s law by teaching their way for many generations, and yet the scripture was never disparate.



**"Keep my commands and follow them. I am the *אֱלֹהִים*. Do not profane my holy name. I must be acknowledged as holy by the Israelites. I am the *אֱלֹהִים*, who makes you holy and who brought you out of Egypt to be your Supreme Father. I am the *אֱלֹהִים*." (Leviticus 22:31-33)**

Here are a few of what our heavenly Supreme Father had warned HIS people about the law.

***"Do not add to what I command you and do not subtract from it, but keep the commands of the *אֱלֹהִים* your Supreme Father, I give you."* (Deuteronomy 4:2)**

There is one last part to understand why not only Christmas, but other so-called holidays like Easter Sunday, Thanksgiving, or Halloween are all falsely appointed holidays. *אֱלֹהִים* did NOT give us any of this holiday memorial Sabbatical time of the year at all. Because HE has ONLY given us seven true festivals appointed time holidays:

1. Day of Gladness (New Year)
2. Sacrifice of Peace Offering Day (Karbanot of Shalom Minhah)
3. Festival of Unleavened Bread (Chag HaMatzot)
4. Festival of Harvest (CHag HaKatzir)
5. Day of Trumpets (Yom Teruah or Rosh Hashanah)
6. Day of Atonement (Yom Kippur)
7. Festival of Ingathering (Chag HaAsif)

Nothing else was given after all of those sacred appointed true holidays. Yet, we have created many of the false holidays and replaced those sacred holidays. This is why I've discovered why this so-called Christmas holiday is an evil spiritual holiday of the year.

If you still believe there is nothing wrong with Christmas, etc... You then therefore would be blind-mind that there is nothing wrong with the dark path of eternal death. As you would consider a wish for darkness and death. So, if not what you would desire for darkness and death, then repent by turning around to *אֱלֹהִים*'s teaching way.
