- 1. Micah 1:4 (NLT) "The mountains melt beneath his feet and flow into the valleys like wax in a fire, like water pouring down a hill."
- 2. Psalm 97:5 (ESV) "The mountains melt like wax before the Lord, before the Lord of all the earth."
- 3. Deuteronomy 4:11 (KJV) "And ye came near and stood under the mountain; and the mountain burned with fire unto the midst of heaven, with darkness, clouds, and thick darkness."
- 4. Psalm 104:31-32 "May the glory of the LORD endure forever; may the LORD rejoice in his works—he who looks at the earth, and it trembles, who touches the mountains, and they smoke."
- 5. Deuteronomy 5:23 "And it came to pass, when you heard the voice out of the middle of the darkness, (for the mountain did burn with fire,) that you came near to me, even all the heads of your tribes, and your elders."
- 6. Isaiah 64:1-5 "Oh, that you would burst from the heavens and come down! How the mountains would quake in your presence! As fire causes wood to burn and water to boil, your coming would make the nations tremble. Then your enemies would learn the reason for your fame! When you came down long ago, you did awesome deeds beyond our highest expectations. And oh, how the mountains quaked! For since the world began, no ear has heard and no eye has seen a God like you, who works for those who wait for him! You

- welcome those who gladly do good, who follow godly ways. But you have been very angry with us, for we are not godly. We are constant sinners; how can people like us be saved?"
- 7. Exodus 19:18 "Mount Sinai was covered with smoke, because the Lord descended on it in fire. The smoke billowed up from it like smoke from a furnace, and the whole mountain trembled violently."
- 8. Judges 5:5 "The mountains gushed before the LORD, This Sinai, before the LORD God of Israel."
- 9. Psalm 144:5 "Bow your heavens, OLORD, and come down: touch the mountains, and they shall smoke."
- 10. Nahum 1:5-6 (NIV) "The mountains quake before him and the hills melt away. The earth trembles at his presence, the world and all who live in it. 6 Who can withstand his indignation? Who can endure his fierce anger? His wrath is poured out like fire; the rocks are shattered before him."
- 11. Isaiah 29:6 "You shall be visited of the LORD of hosts with thunder, and with earthquake, and great noise, with storm and tempest, and the flame of devouring fire."
- 12. Genesis 1:1 "In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth."
- 13. Nehemiah 9:6 "You alone are the LORD. You created the heavens, the highest heavens with all their host, the earth and all that is on it, the seas and all that is in them. You give life to all things, and the host of heaven worships You."
- 14. Psalm 19:1 "The heavens declare the glory of God; the skies proclaim the work of his hands."
- 15. Genesis 1:7 "So God made the expanse and separated the waters beneath it from the waters above. And it was so."
- 16. Genesis 1:16 "And God made two great lights; the greater light to rule the day, and the lesser light to rule the night: he made the stars also."
