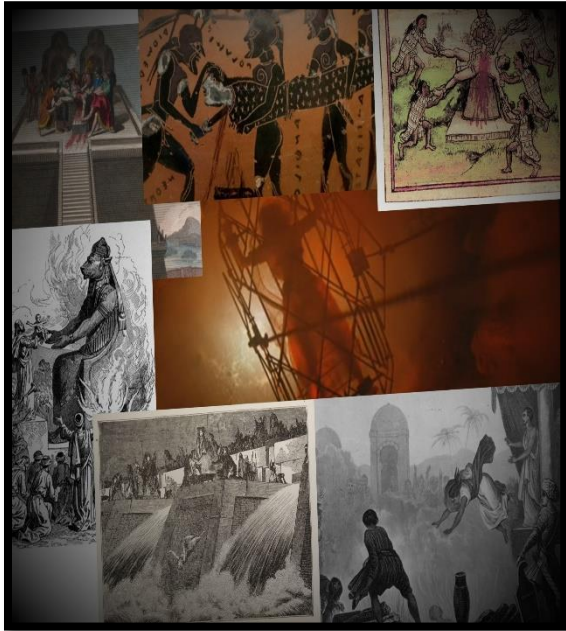


The Sealing Blood of the Covenant Promise



I, Bro. Pouliot will say this again, do U realize our Maker, the I AM who I AM, **אֶלֹהִים** who made heaven and earth hate human sacrifice? HE mentioned killing human beings is an abomination according to Genesis 9:6. I have already addressed this from my first announcement in 2021 and wrote it on the [PowerPoint Presentation \(attest.tv\)](https://www.attest.tv). This topic document here is only about why **אֶלֹהִים** did NOT send anyone (this including Jesus/YahuSha) to die for men's sins. Why we should NOT worship Jesus/YahuSha who claimed to be from heaven, is the Son of the Maker. Or Jesus/YahuSha who is HE, the Father as **אֶלֹהִים**.

The main reason why so many people believe that "if" Jesus had not shed his blood for us, we could never be forgiven for our sins. Claiming what the book of Hebrews 9:22 had explained referral to what the book of Leviticus 17:11 teaches:

"... without the shedding of blood, there can be no forgiveness of sins."

So, there we go! The blood of Jesus Christ is necessary, and the Old Testament (OT) sacrifices & offerings lamb is the foreshadowing about the future coming of Christ who will ONE time atonement die for people's sin.... End of story, right???. The answer is NO, a lot of people misunderstand what the instruction of the blood sacrifices & offerings was all about. It is NOT true about Jesus (human) blood sacrifices as foreshadowing Lamb of God, the Lamb sacrifices to cleanness and forgiveness of our sins.



It is true that without the shedding of blood, there can be no forgiveness of sins, but what people first misunderstand about this statement is what blood was it talking about? It was talking about the animal's blood, NOT a man's blood. Secondly, people also do not realize and/or forget about the rule of sacrifice of atonement. According to Leviticus 16:5-7, goats or bulls were used for atonement sacrifice purposes. That is why on the Day of Atonement the priests did not perform blood sacrifice of the lamb at all. This is one of the reasons why this did not foreshadow Jesus as Lamb of God.

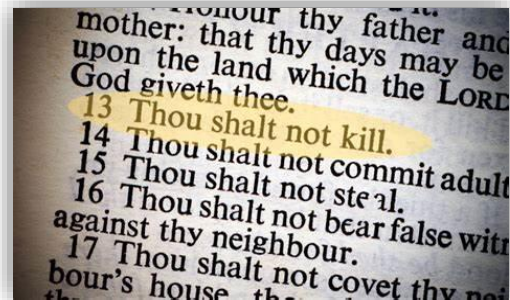
So, killing only Jesus is NOT okay at all. I know that **אֱלֹהִים** did NOT send anyone to die for any one because Deuteronomy 24:16 said:

“Fathers are not to be put to death for children, and children are not to be put to death for fathers—each one is to be put to death for his own sin”

אֱלֹהִים is our father and HE sure did NOT send ANY of HIS sons to die. **אֱלֹהִים** also made it clear, whoever kills someone must be put to death according to Exodus 20:13. That is why one of the Ten Commandments said, **“You shall not murder”**. This is the basic rule that no man has the authority to kill anyone for their own decision reason.

Many of us need to understand better about Leviticus 17:11-14, what it really means to us. What does the animal's blood sacrifice for? Once a person reads the scripture very carefully, you might end up noticing what and why was this blood sprinkled toward the congregation (people)? Is it representative of something? The answer is yes, it represents the sealing of **אֱלֹהִים**'s covenant promises to HIS people. Again, the animal's blood is to represent as life promise, that is what needs to be clearly understood. The OT teachings of the sprinkling of the blood on people is a significance to a vital commitment sign promise, a covenant between **אֱלֹהִים** & HIS people.



Once again, Leviticus 17:11-14 sacrifices blood is not about saving or cleaning any one from sin. Either the animal or humans' blood cannot simply forgive/clean a person's life from wrongdoing. What we need to be better understood is, the blood that sprinkled on people represents life (see

Leviticus 17:14). The sprinkled of the blood life is the sealing promise of אלהים. The sacrifice blood once again is the representation of the sealing of a covenant promise to the people of Israel. Like the red wax seals post on the covenant promise.

This explains why אלהים do not delight in the blood sacrifices according to the book of Ezekiel 18:32. That is why King David, Isaiah, & Hosea all knew about this as well [See Psalm 50:8; Hosea 6:6; Psalm 51:16; Psalm 40:6-8; Isaiah 1:11-31; Jeremiah 7:21-23].

Let's over look at the example why was Abraham being tested, to sacrificing his own son Isaac as a burnt offering? Abraham passes the test after אלהים stops him before he nearly kills his son. Why does all this happen? It's because he passed the obedience test, by obeying HIS command. Abraham knew אלהים sacrifice humans was an abomination. Abraham would still pass the test even if he kills his son because he listened and obey אלהים's command earlier. Still, אלהים stopped him because he does not desire to have human sacrifice and told him to grab the ram instead (Gen 22:9-13).



Shedding the human's blood is clearly an abomination, even the book of Ezekiel chapter 18 said no one can die for ANYONE else's sin. Further in this chapter, it teaches us that all we must first know the wrongdoing and stop sinning. Confess אלהים and ask for forgiveness for sins. Start doing what is right and good. That is why the law was written on the two table stones in the first place; to remind us of what is wrong and how to resolve it.
